## **Citizens' Climate Lobby Earth Day Artwork Contest Rules**



- **1. Who can participate:** Any child who attends Stewart Middle School.
- 2. Artwork content: Artwork should address the theme, "What I Love About Planet Earth."
- **3. Artwork format:** The original medium can be anything chosen by the artist. The submission must be electronic using a common format such as pdf, jpeg, bmp, or png.
- **4. Originality of work:** Adults can assist contestants with logistical support, supplies, interpreting rules, and converting to electronic format. Creation of the artwork is the sole responsibility of the contestant.
- 5. Submitting artwork: Artwork must be received at <a href="mailto:info@ccltacoma.org">info@ccltacoma.org</a> no later than midnight, April 8, 2021. The submission must be accompanied by a completed Citizens' Climate Lobby Earth Day Artwork Contest Application.
- 6. Permission for Citizens' Climate Lobby use: Parents/guardians must include a signed release form giving their permission for the submitted artwork to be used by Citizens' Climate Lobby.
- 7. Judging: A three-person panel of Citizens' Climate Lobby volunteer judges will select a first, second, and third place winner from the submissions. All contestants will receive a certificate of appreciation for their submission.
- **8. Judging criteria:** Submissions will be judged on originality, artistic value, and expression of the theme.
- **9. Announcing winners:** Winners will be notified via the same medium as the artwork was submitted (email or text), no later than April 20, 2021.
- **10. Prizes:** First Place \$300; Second Place \$200, Third Place \$100. Prize money will be awarded to a winner's class in the name of the contestant. Funds are to be used as the teacher of the class chooses in teaching some aspect of care for the environment.
